

# Surface Water and Groundwater

## Stormwater and Wastewater Compliance

We provide assistance on permitting and compliance issues related to stormwater and point-source discharges regulated under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES). These services include preparation of Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPPs), permit applications, development and implementation of Best Management Practices (BMPs), and discharge monitoring.

## Groundwater Monitoring and Permit Compliance

Cameron-Cole conducts groundwater compliance monitoring at numerous landfills and waste treatment/recycling facilities operating under rigorous Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit requirements. Cameron-Cole prepares, modifies, and implements groundwater sampling and analysis plans at

facilities with monitoring networks that often include hundreds of monitoring wells and extensive analyte lists. Critical elements of the monitoring programs include database management, quality assurance/quality control, health and safety, and reporting.

## SPCC Plans

The Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure (SPCC) rule applies to non-transportation-related facilities with an aboveground oil storage capacity of greater than 1,320 gallons that could reasonably be expected to discharge oil to navigable waters. Cameron-Cole's compliance team conducts facility inspections to develop a detailed oil storage inventory and assess potential areas of noncompliance. We then prepare a site-specific SPCC plan with the required Professional Engineer (P.E.) certification, facility diagram, requirements for tank inspections and testing, secondary containment, employee training, site security, and spill response and reporting.
